About The CWE examination

The Certified Wine Educator (CWE) Exam is a unique certification that not only tests a candidate's wine knowledge, but also validates his or her tasting acumen and teaching ability. This certification is widely recognized and highly regarded by the international wine and spirits industry.

This intense undertaking comprises a theory exam, two blind tasting exams and a presentation skills demonstration, along with requiring candidates to provide evidence of Responsible Beverage Alcohol Service certification. Detailed information on each component of the CWE Exam is included in our website.

All candidates pursuing the CWE certification must already possess the Certified Specialist of Wine (CSW) certification. There are no exceptions to this rule regardless of a candidate's background or credentials.

Candidates who successfully pass all components of the CWE Exam are entitled to use the CWE post-nominal as part of their professional signature. They will also receive a certificate (suitable for framing) and a CWE lapel pin.

The CWE Exam is self-study educational program. While candidates often use the fifteen-module on-line SWE Wine Academy, and the CSW Study Guide among their studies, the Society has put together a recommended list of educational sources to assist candidates in preparing for this challenging exam.
